

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-71

**RESOLUTION APPOINTING ADOLPH "VAL" VALFRE, JR.,
TO FILL VACANCY ON FOREST GROVE CITY COUNCIL,
APPOINTED TERM OF OFFICE EXPIRING NOVEMBER, 2020**

WHEREAS, Pursuant to City Charter, § 31, there currently exists a vacancy on the City Council brought about by the resignation of Councilor Matthew Vandehey, effective October 10, 2017, who established permanent residency in the City of Banks; and

WHEREAS, the advertised City Council vacancy application period was duly-noticed in the *NewsTimes* on October 18, October 25 and November 1, 2017; and

WHEREAS, at the close of business, 5 p.m., November 3, 2017, seven Letters of Intent and Interest for the Council vacancy were received and certified for eligibility and residency requirements pursuant to City Charter § 27 and City Code § 2.075; and

WHEREAS, the Council conducted oral interviews in open Work Session held on Monday, November 13, 2017, and conducted its deliberations at the regular Council meeting on November 13, 2017; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to City Charter, § 32, and City Code § 2.070-2.080, the Council filled the vacancy by a majority vote of the remaining Councilmembers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF FOREST GROVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to City Charter, § 32, the City Council hereby appoints **ADOLPH "VAL" VALFRE, JR.**, to serve as a member of the Forest Grove City Council for the remainder of the term of office expiring November, 2020.

Section 2. The above-named person shall take and hold office as City Councilor of the City of Forest Grove after taking the Oath of Office, effective November 27, 2017, and/or no later than 20 business days following the appointment by Council.

Section 3. This resolution is effective immediately upon its enactment by the City Council.

BACKGROUND:

Pursuant to City Charter, § 31, there currently exists a vacancy on the City Council brought about by the resignation of Councilor Matthew Vandehey, effective October 10, 2017, who established permanent residency in the City of Banks. The term of office for this position expires November, 2020.

At the close of business, 5 p.m., November 3, 2017, seven Letters of Intent and Interest for the Council vacancy were received and certified for eligibility and residency requirements pursuant to City Charter § 27 and City Code § 2.075. The Council conducted oral interviews in open Work Session held on Monday, November 13, 2017. In addition, Council conducted deliberations on the slate of candidates and casted individual ballots at the regular Council meeting on November 13, 2017. Pursuant to City Charter, § 32, the City Council voted unanimously to appoint **ADOLPH "VAL" VALFRE, JR.**, to serve as a member of the Forest Grove City Council for the remainder of the term of office expiring November, 2020. The above-named person shall take and hold office as City Councilor after taking the Oath of Office, on November 27, 2017, and/or no later than 20 business days following the appointment by Council.
