**WHEREAS**, City Council accept Councilor Vandehey's resignation on October 9, 2017, and declared the Council seat vacant.


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF FOREST GROVE CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The City Council hereby declares the official nameplate, professional photograph and any other city provided property to Matthew Vandehey as surplus to the needs of the City.


**Section 2.** The Mayor is hereby authorized to bestow the official nameplate and professional photograph of the above-named City Councilor on behalf of the City.
