



**Statement of Historical and Architectural Significance:**

The Odd Fellows Hall is a modest building exhibiting very little ornament. Fraternal lodges were often among the more significant architectural gems of a community, but this simple building is an example of a bare bones budget model.

A previous building on 21st Street built in 1912 burned on July 20, 1919. This building was built as a replacement and it is clear that the Odd Fellows chose to go with simplicity and economy for their new lodge.
