REGISTRATION PROCESS

- Registration opens at 6:00am for Forest Grove Residents
- and 10:00am for Non-Residents.

Community members that have applied and been approved for scholarship funds will have them automatically added to their account. They can then use those funds to register online for activities. Scholarship funds will be applied first. The descriptions in this Activity Guide are intended to give a brief overview of classes and activities. More details can be found in our online registration system, Civic Rec. Please note that the information (specifically location and time) available on Civic Rec is ALWAYS the most up-to-date and accurate.

GENERAL POLICY

- Enrollment is subject to space availability.
- Full payment is required at time of registration.
- Many programs have a minimum/maximum enrollment requirement.
- Activities may be canceled if minimum enrollments are not met, so sign up early.
- All rates are rounded to the nearest quarter of a dollar.

PAYMENT

- All information and fees are subject to change without notice.
- Make checks payable to City of Forest Grove. We also accept credit cards and cash.

STATUS

- Senior: A person 65 years of age or older. Proof of age is required.
- Veteran: A person that has served in the U.S. military. Proof of service is required.
- Family: The immediate “parent-child” family unit including only the parent(s) or legal guardian(s), and their children by birth, marriage, adoption, or foster that live together in the same household. No more than two adults per household. Youth are 2-17 years old.
- Disabled: A person with a disability. Proof of awarded designation through Social Security Administration is required.

Discounts for Senior, Veteran, and Disabled only apply to an individual and is not a family discount program.

IN-CITY DISCOUNT

As Forest Grove Parks & Recreation (FGPR) is property tax supported, there is a 30% discounted fee for all participants who reside within the City Limits. The resident fee is listed first and then the fee for participants living outside the City limits.

REFUND POLICY

- Cancellations made less than 72 hours before the first day of a scheduled event/class will not receive a refund or user credit.
- If the purchaser fails to attend a scheduled event/class they registered for, they will not be entitled to a refund or user credit.
- Cancellations made 72 hours or more before the first day of a scheduled event/class will receive a 100% user credit if the fee is less than \$100. For an event/class with a fee of more than \$100, the purchaser can choose between a refund or user credit.
- If Forest Grove Parks & Recreation cancels a scheduled event/class, the purchaser is entitled to a full refund or user credit unless otherwise stated for specific events or classes.

TRANSFER POLICY

- A transfer is defined as “taking a participants’ current registration in a class, activity or shelter reservation and moving it into a different class, activity or reservation.”
- Transfers are not guaranteed and are subject to class and instructor availability, enrollment numbers, etc.

CHILDCARE DISCLAIMER

Day camps and programs offered by FGPR are not designated “Certified Child Care” for tax purposes.

POLICIES & INFORMATION LIABILITY

By signing up for or participating in any FGPR class or activity you agree to the following:

I understand and acknowledge that the City of Forest Grove and its agents, officers, elected officials, volunteers and employees (collectively, the “City”) is willing to authorize me to participate and engage in activities as registered for as associated with the City and on property owned or leased by the City. I understand that all recreational activities have inherent risks, dangers, and hazards that are a part of my performance of and participation in these activities, including but not limited to, bodily injury, disease, strains, fractures, partial and/ or total paralysis, death or other ailments that could result in serious injury and/or permanent disability.

PHOTOGRAPHIC RELEASE

By enrolling or attending any class or activity offered by Forest Grove Parks and Recreation you consent to have your photograph taken and allow use of the photographs for use by Forest Grove Parks and Recreation.

ACCOMMODATION RESOURCES FGPR

Programs are available to people of all abilities with reasonable accommodation. Please contact our offices at least two weeks before the program begins, by phone or email to work with a Coordinator to discuss your needs.

FUN FOR ALL FUND

The Fun For All Fund is a fee assistance service available to residents of the City of Forest Grove. Qualifying recipients may receive assistance to be used towards most recreation and aquatic classes, lessons, memberships, camps, and programs. EXCITING IMPROVEMENTS AT THE AQUATIC CENTER

Forest Grove Parks & Recreation is pleased to share that the Aquatic Center will undergo a series of much-anticipated improvements from March 16 through early June. To complete this work, the Aquatic Center will need to close during the scheduled construction period. These upgrades include a brand-new pool deck, refreshed locker rooms, and several plumbing enhancements—all aimed at improving safety, comfort, and the overall visitor experience.

We recognize how much the community values regular swim sessions, lessons, and family time at the pool. While the closure is temporary, it will help ensure a more modern, accessible, and long-lasting facility for everyone to enjoy. 

LOCKERS

DRESS CODE

All pool, sauna, and hot tub/spa users must wear a swimsuit. Cotton t-shirts, shorts, cut-offs, tank tops, and undergarments are not allowed. Guests who aren't toilet trained must wear a swim diaper. Only Coast Guard-approved life jackets are allowed; water wings, inflatable tubes, and swimsuits with built-in flotation devices are not permitted.

SENSORY SWIM

Lights will be dimmed over both pools with noise levels reduced for a serene atmosphere. Adaptive equipment like noodles, flotation belts, and mats will be available. A parent, guardian, or caregiver receives free admission and must assist swimmer in the water.
